

CHAPTER 9

PVHS Air Force Junior ROTC Letter

Criteria

Award of the Palo Verde High School Air Force Junior ROTC letter is at the discretion of the Senior Aerospace Science Instructor (SASI).



A Palo Verde High School Junior ROTC Letter may be awarded to any cadet who has accumulated the required number of “points” each year.

“Points” do not carry over from one year to the next (for lettering purposes within Junior ROTC, one year is Awards Banquet to Awards Banquet).

To be awarded a PVHS AFJROTC letter, cadets must maintain a grade point average of “C” or better in Junior ROTC, with no “F” or “U” in any PVHS class. Also, any behavior that violates Clark County School District, Palo Verde High School, or Air Force Junior ROTC guidelines, may be cause not to award a letter (i.e. – RPC, suspension, etc.).

A minimum of 100 “points” must be earned to be eligible for a letter or pin. “Points” are earned for each achievement or activity you participate in. Listed below are the point values for each activity:

Administration

The Cadet Wing Commander or their designee initiates a Cadet Tracking Form (Figure 12) to document “points” earned by each cadet.

To receive your Quarter GPA points, you must bring in your report card *within ten (10) school days* of receiving your report card.

Activities completed after the Awards Banquet (drill meets, color guards, community service projects, etc.) are credited to the next school year. Also, fourth quarter GPA’s are carried forward. Eligible cadets must bring their 2nd semester report cards to the ROTC office *within ten (10) school days* after the start of the new school year to receive their points.

After award of the initial Palo Verde High School Junior ROTC Letter, subsequent awards are denoted by award of a silver bar that is worn on the letter.

Junior ROTC Letters and bars will be formally presented at the Awards Banquet.
