

## Secret Recipe of the Month

### Ingredients

- 8 Reese's Peanut Butter Cups (full size)
- 8 Reese's Dark Peanut Butter Cups Miniatures
- 48 Reese's Pieces
- 16 candy eyes
- 1/2 c semi-sweet chocolate chips



1. Melt chocolate chips in microwave until nice and smooth.
2. Transfer melted chocolate to a plastic bag and cut a very small piece off the corner.
3. Pipe a small amount of melted chocolate onto the back of the miniatures and place on the far side of the full size cups.
4. Pipe a small amount of melted chocolate onto the back of the candy eyes and place on the turkey's head (the miniature).
5. Pipe a small amount of melted chocolate onto the side of an orange Reese's Pieces and place on the miniature for the turkey's nose.
6. Pipe a small amount of melted chocolate onto the back of Reese's Pieces and place at the top of the full size cup for the feathers.
