Tic Tac Toe



Recipe

Pumpkin Cake

- 2 teaspoons **baking powder**
- 2 cups (250g) **all purpose flour**
- 1 teaspoon **baking soda**
- 1 teaspoon **salt**
- 1 and 1/2 teaspoons **ground cinnamon**
- 2 teaspoons **pumpkin pie spice***
- 1 cup (240ml) canola or vegetable **oil***
- 4 large **eggs**
- 1 cup (200g) packed light or dark **brown sugar**
- 1/2 cup (100g) **granulated sugar**
- 1 (15 ounce) can **pumpkin puree**
- 1 and 1/2 teaspoons **pure vanilla extract**

Cream Cheese Frosting

- 8 ounces (224g) full-fat block **cream cheese**, softened to room temperature
- 1/2 cup (115g) **unsalted butter**, softened to room temperature
- 3 cups (360g) **confectioners' sugar**, plus an extra 1/4 cup if needed
- 1 teaspoon **pure vanilla extract**
- 1/8 teaspoon **salt**

Instructions

Preheat the oven to 350°F (177°C) and grease a 9×13 inch baking pan. I always use [this glass pan](#). Whisk the flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, and pumpkin pie spice together in a large bowl. Set aside. Whisk the oil, eggs, brown sugar, granulated sugar, pumpkin, and vanilla extract together until combined. Pour the wet ingredients into the dry ingredients and use a mixer or whisk until completely combined. Batter will be thick.

Spread batter into the prepared pan. Bake for 30-36 minutes. Baking times vary, so keep an eye on yours. The cake is done when a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. If you find the top or edges of the cake is/are browning too quickly in the oven, loosely cover it with aluminum foil.

Remove the cake from the oven and set the entire pan on a wire rack. Allow to cool completely. After about 45 minutes, I usually place the cake in the refrigerator to speed things up.

Make the frosting: In a large bowl using a handheld or stand mixer fitted with a paddle or whisk attachment, beat the cream cheese and butter together on high speed until smooth and creamy. Add 3 confectioners' sugar, vanilla, and salt. Beat on low speed for 30 seconds, then switch to high speed and beat for 2 minutes. If you want the frosting a little thicker, add the extra 1/4 cup of confectioners sugar (I add it). Spread the frosting on the cooled cake.
