

CHAPTER 3

Admission, Transfer, and Disenrollment

Admission. To be eligible for enrollment and to continue in the Palo Verde High School Air Force Junior ROTC program, each student must be:

- Selected by the SASI, in coordination with the Principal or a designated representative, to ensure enrolled students meet acceptable standards.
- Enrolled in and attending a regular course of instruction at Palo Verde High School.
- Enrolled in Algebra I or higher.
- A citizen or national of the United States or an alien admitted for permanent residence.
- Physically fit. Students must be qualified, approved or capable of participating in the Palo Verde High School Physical Education program.

For:

- MS-II: Must have successfully completed both semesters of Military Science I.
- MS-III: Must have successfully completed Military Science I and II. Cadets must also successfully complete Cadet Leadership Course, or forty (40) hours of community service, and the MS-II drill sequence.
- MS-IV: Must have successfully completed Military Science I, II and III, fifty (50) hours of community service, the MS-III drill sequence, and be recommended by the AFJROTC Staff (also see Chapter 6, Criteria).

Note: returning cadets who did not successfully complete both semesters the previous year must repeat the entire year for promotion/year group consideration purposes.

Transfer. Students from Army, Navy, Marine Corps or other Air Force JROTC units may be admitted with full credit for all

academics satisfactorily completed. Transfer students will be awarded a rank commensurate to that of their PVHS peers.

Disenrollment. The decision to remove a cadet from the Palo Verde JROTC Program is made by the Principal (or designated representative) in coordination with the SASI. Removal should be a last resort preceded by sustained and corrective counseling. A cadet may be removed for any of the following reasons:

- Failure to maintain acceptable JROTC standards.
- Inaptitude or indifference to training.
- Discipline problems.
- Undesirable character traits.
- Failure to remain enrolled at Palo Verde High School.
- Physically unfit -- unable to perform drill.
- Individual request.
- Any other reason deemed appropriate by the Principal and SASI.



Reserve Cadet. A Reserve Cadet is basically a cadet who cannot enroll in AFJROTC courses within the school and is in the AFJROTC program for the sole purpose of participating in co-curricular (after school)

activities. To qualify as a Reserve Cadet, a student will meet one of the following criteria, with SASI concurrence:

- 1. The student has completed the entire AFJROTC Academic Program at the school and cannot continue without duplicating curriculum courses.
- 2. The student is currently enrolled in a 4x4 scheduled unit, has completed an AFJROTC course during Term #1 (the first semester), but is not participating in an AFJROTC course during Term #2 (the second semester).
- 3. The student is in a Traditional scheduled school, but cannot participate in the AFJROTC academic program for that particular year due to only duplicated courses being offered.
- 4. A student must have been a cadet for at least one academic year (academic term for 4x4) prior to being considered a Reserve Cadet.
- 5. Reserve Cadets may participate in all AFJROTC activities (community service, drill team, honor guard, etc.). Time in reserve status does not count towards the Certificate of Completion, nor do Reserve Cadets count toward minimum unit enrollment or unit funding. Reserve Cadets may retain their uniform for the entire academic year.
