

CHAPTER 8

Certificates of Completion/Training and Advanced Enlistment

Certificates of Completion/Training. Upon completion of Air Force Junior ROTC academic requirements, two types of certificates *may be* awarded:

1. Certificate of Completion (AFROTC Form 310 - Figure 10) is awarded for successful completion of three (3) or four (4) years.
2. Certificate of Training (AF Form 1256 - Figure 11) is awarded for successful completion of two (2) years.

Since the certificates are based only on Air Force Junior ROTC performance, they may be awarded even if a student does not graduate from high school.

A student presenting evidence of three academic years of Junior ROTC *may be* entitled to no less than 1 year of credit in the Senior ROTC program.

Certificates of Completion and Certificates of Training are formally presented to graduating cadets at the annual Awards Banquet.

Advanced Enlistment in an Active or Reserve Component of a Military Service.

A high school graduate who successfully completes at least two years of Junior ROTC (and is awarded a Certificate of Training) is entitled to enlist at the grade of E-2 immediately on enlistment.

A high school graduate who successfully completes at last three years of Junior ROTC (and is awarded a Certificate of

Completion) is entitled to enlist at the grade of E-3 immediately on enlistment (Air Force ONLY!). At their discretion, other military services *may* award the grade of E-3 on initial enlistment.
